Brothers,

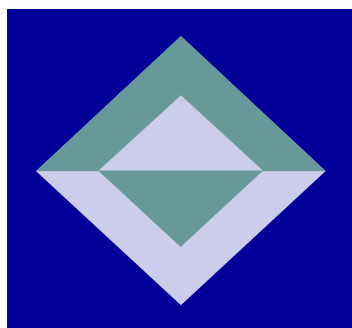

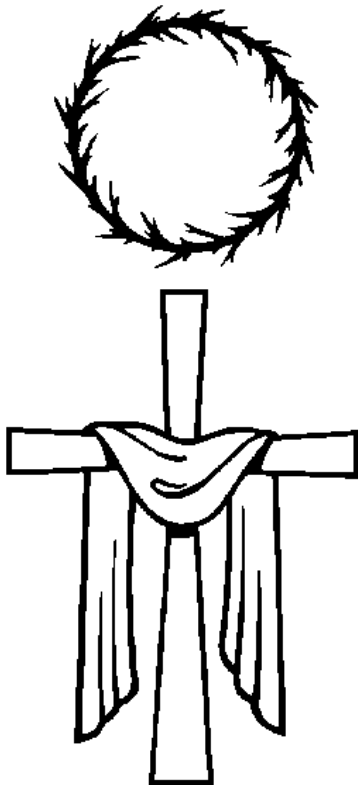
### Welcome To Our New Knight
