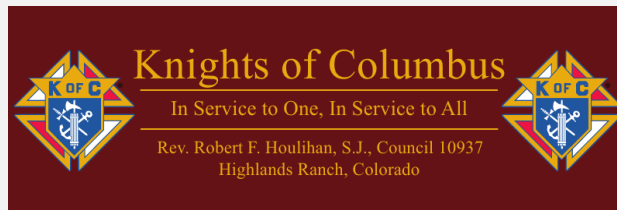

## Rosary Walk Update

Dear Brother Knights:

Your response was great. Fortunately,  
we had a lot of Knights and some  
parishioners helping with the first  
phase of the Rosary Walk construction  
on Saturday May 5th.

This turned out to be a big project,  
clearing a path about 180 yards long.

Here is what we accomplished:

1) Raked the dead plants and as many  
live plants out of the proposed path as  
possible.



2) Rototilled the path to get rid of the  
vegetation.



3) Laid down weed barrier along the  
whole path.



4) Laid down stepping stones.



5) Placed pea gravel material on top of  
the Weed Barrier.



6. Rototilled a walking path along the  
fence line to the Pax Christi driveway  
entrance.





Still to be done:

- 1) We did not quite finish, so we still have some weed barrier, pea gravel and stepping stones to lay down.
- 2) Put up Marker posts.
- 3) Put a Cross at the beginning of the Walk (proposed).
- 4) Place a statue of Mary at the beginning of the first decade (proposed).
- 5) Place benches along the way (proposed).
- 6) Plant some flower gardens to give it some color (proposed).

So, there will be lots of opportunities for improvements over time.

Our next work session is Saturday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 8:30am.

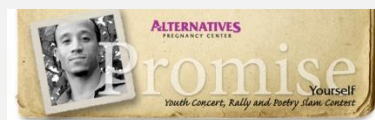

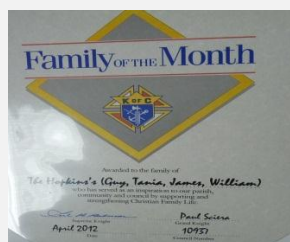
