The March for Life is the 17th of January in downtown Denver. There will be a bus at Pax to transport parishioners to the march on a first come first serve basis.


Two resolutions for endorsement were presented:





40 Cans For Lent will be held during lent. We will collect and take all donated food to the Denver Rescue Mission on March 28th.


The next soup kitchen at Denver Rescue Mission is forthcoming. Dates will be determined later.

The basketball shootout is coming up. Scholarships are being worked on.


h. Newsletter – Brennan Mendus
