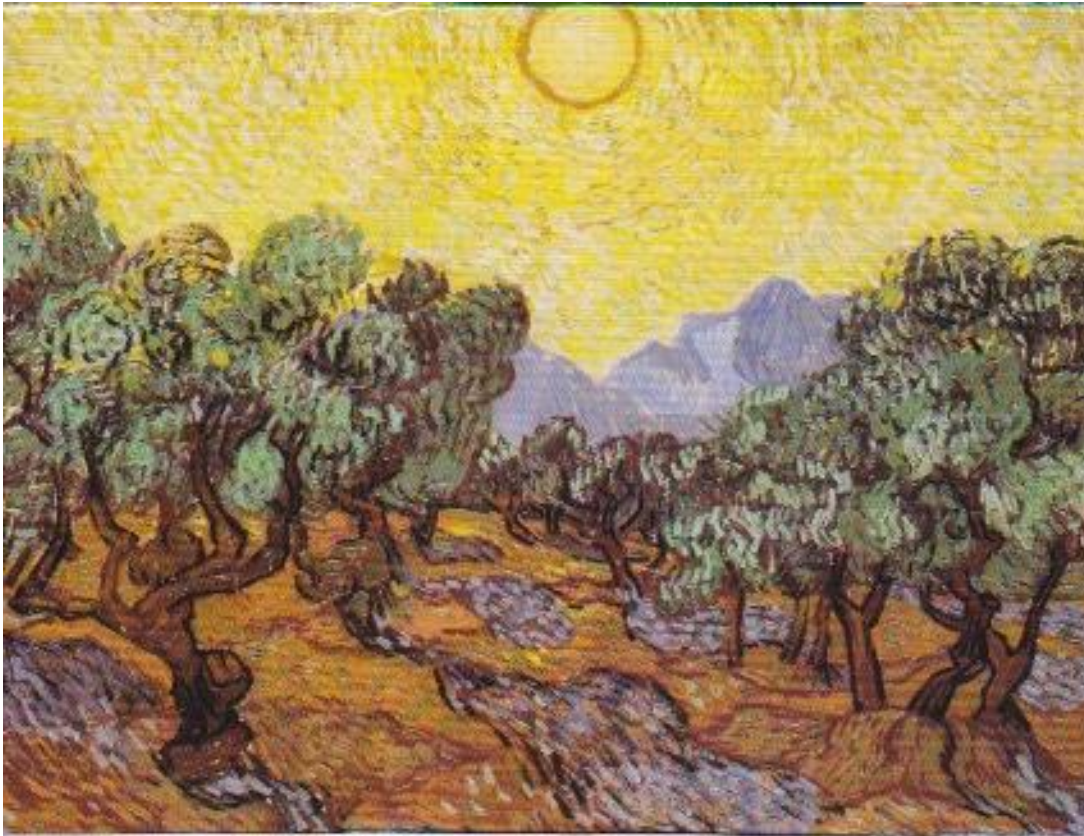

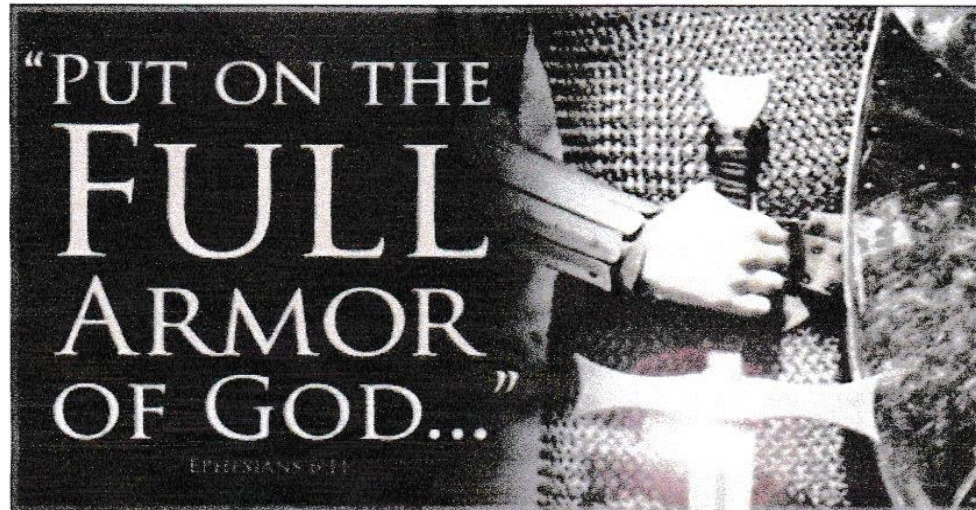

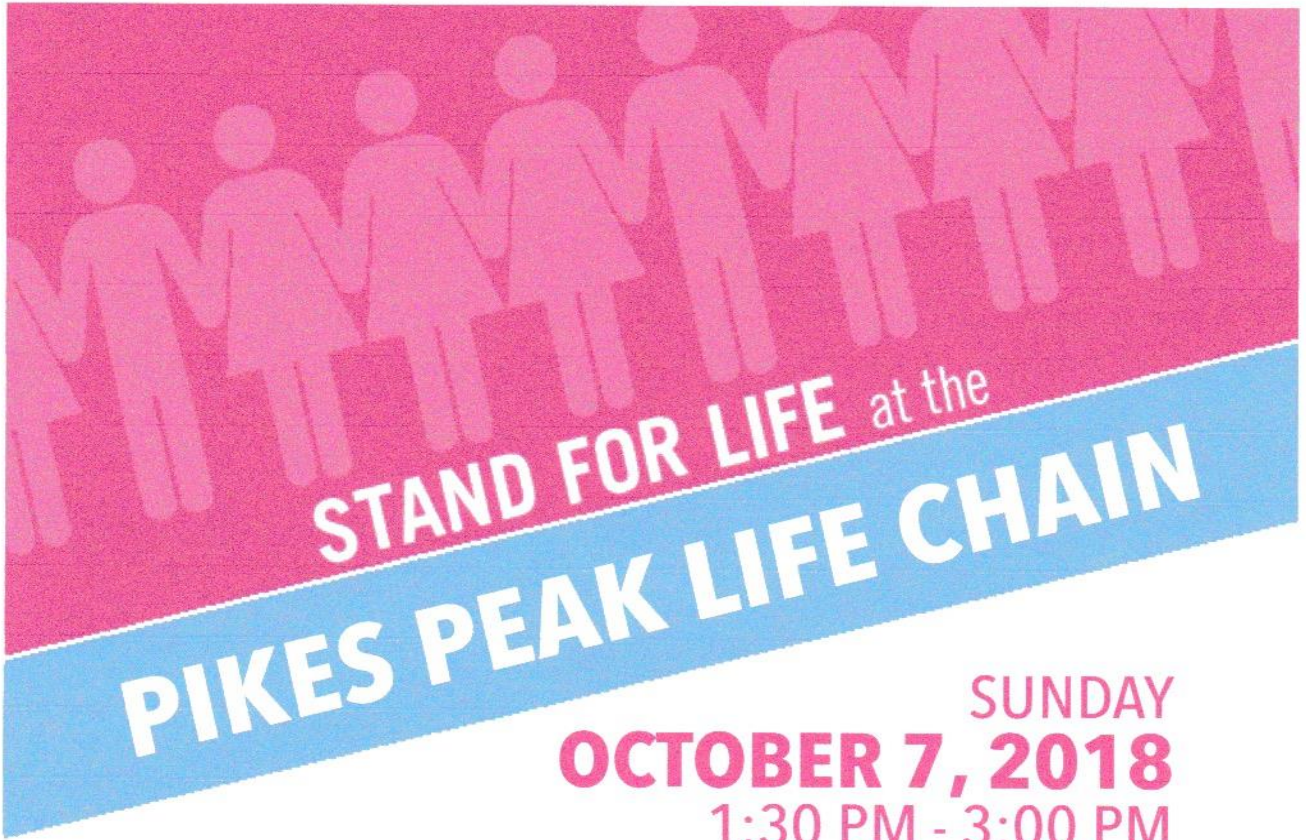

A movie depicting the actions of infamous Pennsylvania abortionist and convicted killer Kermit Gosnell has had its first official trailer released.

Titled "Gosnell: The Trial of America's Biggest Serial Killer," the film's trailer was officially released earlier this week and reported on by news outlets, including [the Hollywood Reporter](#).

The cast features Dean Cain, who starred in the TV series "Lois & Clark: The New Adventures of Superman" and the
