 - The big push was membership, which is down state wide. Consequently, the state is down on its quota for new members. Nevertheless, the state is seeing an increase in younger members and minorities joining our ranks. An encouraging sign.
 - Concerning KOC Insurance programs and products, the state has seen an increase in this area.
 - Emphasis was placed on members getting Safe Environment training.
 - There was discussion on the use of technology and how this has helped in terms of meetings, conferences, and fundraising. The state is encouraging councils to get creative in the use of the various applications. For example, our council used e-payment methods, very successfully, for the Thanksgiving Basket drive campaign.
 - In terms of technology, there was also some discussion about doing the soccer and free throw challenges virtually, more information to follow.
 - Overall, Joe said it was a very successful and informative meeting.


We have a limited capacity for seating during our Masses, and we will NOT be taking reservations for these Masses. The parking lot will open 45 minutes prior to each Mass, and we will simply take people until we reach the limit. An usher will seat you according to availability and the size of your party. You may be seated in the Great Hall with a live feed visible on the screen. You will be seated when you arrive, so there will be no opportunity to save seats for others. Your entire party should arrive at the same time, even if in separate cars, or you will not be able to sit together.

In an effort to reach as many people as possible, we will also be offering the opportunity to <u>listen to</u> the audio of Mass and receive Holy Communion from the comfort and safety of your car at the 2pm and 4:30pm Masses. When it is time for communion, EMHCs will come outside to distribute the Precious Body of Christ. Traffic managers will direct cars into position to receive. Families who have members with mobility issues, and those who are at higher risk, may wish to choose this method to limit their exposure to other households, while still receiving our blessed Lord.

Arrival process

When your car arrives at Pax, a traffic manager will greet you. (There will be NO parking at Rock Canyon. All cars should enter the Pax Christi lot and be directed according to capacity and needs.) Please see the attached diagram of our traffic pattern for these Masses.

- If you are going inside, you will give the total <u>number of people in your vehicle</u> to the attendant and drive straight ahead to park.
- If you are remaining in your car to listen to the audio, you will give the total <u>number of people</u> who are receiving communion in your vehicle, then turn left and be directed to parking.
- Once we reach the limit for indoor seating, all cars will be directed to the "remain in car" area. If you do not wish to listen from your car, you must leave the parking lot. You may return at a later time for a different Mass or watch the online recording from home on Christmas Day.
